

GREEN GLUE noiseproofing sealant

Prepare for Application

- Make sure the surfaces that are to be sealed are clean.
- Cut a 1/4" hole in the tip of the tube with a utility knife.
- Screw nozzle tightly over the tip of the tube and cut 1/4" hole in the tip of the nozzle.
- When the nozzle is cut, place the tube in a standard 28 ounce caulk gun to prepare for installation.

Apply Sealant

A very common application of Noiseproofing Sealant is filling 1/8" to 1/4" gaps where the drywall meets the floor and ceiling. Other applications include spaces around electrical outlets. The Sealant should not be used around pipes or copper based materials.

Apply 48 hours before painting to allow for drying time. Drywall tape and mud can be applied directly over Green Glue Noiseproofing Sealant.
